Probably ſet from Juv031 (Venice, de Tortis, 1485) which has the ſame collation, though with a ſlightly different page-impoſition. The preliminaries occupy one page fewer.

The colophon exists in ſeveral ſtates. That given here is found in the British Library, Bodleian, Columbia UL, Harvard and the BSB digitiſed copies. There are tranſcriptions of variants in Hain and in V.O. Ludwig, *Jahrbuch des Stiftes Kloſterneuburg*, viii, 1920. As ſome of theſe variants correct miſtakes, it is likely that they are examples of ſtop-press correction.
