First dated edition of Juvenal printed in Lyon

The first Lyonese book to be printed in roman type

The location of the colophon between the end of the commentary and the start of the *Defensio* suggests that this edition may have been reprinted from one of the earliest editions with this commentary. It seems probable that the copy text was the first such edition, Juv015, whose colophon has an almost identical wording.

Updike states that this is the earliest book to be printed in roman type in Lyon (Updike, *Printing types*, 1922, i, 91 and plate 39).
