Set from Locatellus’s edition of the ſame year (Juv040) with the addition of another
commentary.

This book ſeems to have been one of the firſt produced by Tacuinus, whoſe earlieſt book
is dated Auguſt 1492 (BMC). It is the firſt of a ſeries of Juvenals from this preſs (1494/5,
1498, 1501, 1509, 1512, 1522).

The firſt gathering of the text (ſignature a) is ſet in different types and in a different ſtyle
from the reſt of the book. On a4^v and a5^r (the inner forme of the inner ſheet of the
gathering) both the text and commentary are ſet in the ſmaller ſize of type. Theſe types
(81R, 104R and a few greek characters) are attributed by BMC to the preſs of de Soardis,
who preſumably was working under contract to Tacuinus or elſe ſtarted the book and ſold
out his intereſt after completing the firſt gathering. Another poſſibility is that it proved

necessary to reset the first gathering and that this work was given to another printer. The cramped appearance of a4^v/a5^r suggests some form of copy fitting.

Gatherings a–1 were re-used in 1494/5 in a partial re-issue by Tacuinus with the other gatherings re-set (Juv045).
