Only edition of Juvenal printed in Turin

Set from the edition of Locatellus (Venice, 1492, Juv040), not from that of de Ragazonibus (Juv039) as stated by Graesse (iii, 518). The title page announces a commentary by Probus which is in fact part of Valla's commentary (BMC).

The inclusion of additional matter by Bugellanus suggests that he may have had a hand in preparing the edition in the printing house, including perhaps the amendments to Calderinus's commentary which are announced on the title page. His *Epigramma* (r4^r) was set as prose by the printers; it is in fact written in elegiac couplets:

Hic satyrus quondam quem Romam misit Aquinum
Iunius & Decius cum Iuuenale fuit.
Libertinus ei genitor uel diues alumnus
Subdubito fuerit tempore Calue tuo.
Aetatis medio declamat. Turba uirorum
Audiit: in paridem secula seua notat.
Praefectos pelopeya facit: sub principe Caluo
Dixit: & exilium functus honore tulit.
Ductor in Aegyptum cohortis: ultima clausit
Vitae: bis octo quom sibi lustra forent.
Sed satyri extincti uiuet per secula fama.
Caesar in hanc poteris iuris habere nihil.

Bugellanus is associated with other editions printed by Turin by de Benedictis and Suigus in 1492 and c. 1495 (BodInc Online, M-091 and GW 0571910N). He gave an oration at the Academy in Turin c. 1495, which was printed by Benedictis and Suigus (ISTC ib01276500; Nickel, 2003, 155).
