

**Juv045. Juvenal, with the commentaries of A. Mancinellus, D. Calderinus, and G. Valla

Paper: Super-chancery paper (estimated sheet size 45 × 33.5 cm): largest recorded page size 31.5 × 21.5 cm (Columbia UL).

The woodcut on the title page had already been used in a similar function in a Persius printed by Tacuinus in November 1494.

The privilege (&7^v) was granted for ten years by the Venetian authorities to ‘Giovanni Tridino, che vuole stampare «elegantissimos quosdam Commentarios in Iuvenalem, editos per eruditissimum Antonium Mancinellum»’ (Fulin 37). Any penalties would be divided equally between the plaintiff and the Arsenal. The privilege has the same date as the colophon. A similar ten-year privilege was issued to Tacuinus in 1494 for his edition of Ovid’s *Ars amandi* and *Remedium amoris*, which is bound with the Juvenal in the British Library copy.

This edition is a partial resetting of Juv042. ISTC reports ‘Quires b-l are a re-issue of the sheets of the edition of 2 Dec. 1492, Goff J662 (BMC). Quire a can be found in 8 leaves (re-issues of the earlier edition), cf. BMC, and also reset in 10 leaves, printed (as the rest of the new setting) in types 108R and 82R, cf. Bod-inc and Sheppard.’ Gatherings ABm–z& (and, in some copies, gathering a) are printed from a new setting of type (82R),

whereas the remainder of the book (gatherings b–l) consists of sheets printed as part of edition Juv042 (80R). The reset state of gathering a occupies two more leaves than in Juv042 and the foliation numbers IX and X had to be repeated. The different states can be recognised by the different sizes of commentary type used. The Uppsala copy seems to have new sheets throughout.
