The third edition of this book published by Gaynard. The letter on A1<sup>v</sup> is dated 1498, suggesting that it was set from the original 1498 edition (Juv052) and not from Juv055 in which the date had been altered. The title page has been restyled, with a frame composed of four separate decorated rules, a woodcut and greater use of red ink. A saving of fourteen leaves has been made in the size of the edition.

Greek words are transcribed.

There seems to be a predominantly German distribution of copies.
