Presumably set from Juv048 (Zwolle, c. 1496) or from a lost intermediary with Buschius’s  
poem and Mancinellus’s *Argumenta*. Juv077 (Cologne, 1510) is clearly a close reprint of  
the present edition: it has the same title, colophon and number of leaves; it also has leaded  
lines and wide margins.
