Balsamo states that the catalogue of the Biblioteca Ambrosiana lists such an edition and gives its shelfmark. More recently EDIT16 lists what appears to be the same edition at the Episcopal Seminary in Novara but without giving any indication of its contents. It may have the four commentaries edited by Sebastianus Ducius which Scinzenzeler had printed in 1501 (Juv057) or possibly Britannicus's commentary which he was to print in 1514 (Juv088). Probably the former, since the 1514 Britannicus edition has additional material and survives in a number of copies; this 1508 edition would be more likely to be the last with the cumbersome fifteenth-century commentaries than the first edition with new material.
