Fourth counterfeit Aldine edition.

The fleur de lys is associated with the bookseller Barthélemy Trot. Baudrier (viii, p.410) writes 'Les contrefaçons publiées par l'association Gabiano-Trot forment ce qu'on peut appeler la seconde série de contrefaçons aldines; ... Elles portent généralement une fleur de lis florentine rouge, analogue à celle dont s'est servi Philippo Giunta, à la même époque, à Florence.' Dated Aldine counterfeits in this series seem to occur mainly around 1510–1512 and later.

The *explicit* 'FINIS.' found at the end of the Juvenal and of the Persius suggests that this edition was set from Juv068, as do the use of Greek type and the form of the signatures.

The page size suggest that it is using the new narrow median sheets size, similar to earlier Aldines and their counterfeits.
