Typography: 100It (with very elaborate capitals); 80It; no Greek (text in roman transcription); no initials: 3-line spaces with guide letters; 24 lines; type area 119(129) × 59(76) mm; no catchwords; signed \$ i.–\$ ii., also \$ \$.i and \$ i; running titles: 'Iunii Iuuinalis Aquinatis || Satyra Prima' (etc.)

Paper: Narrow median paper (42 × 35 cm); page size 15.5 × 9.5 cm (British Library).

Presumably a copy of Badius's edition of 1512 (Juv080); the date is interpreted as 14 March 1513 n.s. (before Easter).

Set in Le Rouge's rather eccentric italic type. The running titles are set in 80It in sig. A and in 100It on A2^r and in the rest of the book.

The paper is taller than a normal super-chancery, as with other Aldines and their imitators, and with a width-to-height ratio of 1 : 1.6 is probably the Aldine narrow median identified by Paul Needham (1994).
