Apparently set from the Milanese edition of the same year published by the brothers de Legnano (Juv088). Both have the incorrect register which lists gathering a as in six. The matter within the compartment on the title page is printed in red. The title page exists in two states, presumably distinguishing copies to be sold by Gorgonzola from those of Minutianus himself. The letter by the younger Minutianus seems to be attacking the inaccuracies of the rival Legnano edition (Juv086). Sander records that there are only eleven woodcuts in this edition. Minutianus had published an earlier plain-text Juvenal (Juv054).

The description is verified in part from xeroxes of the Munich and Leeuwarden copies.
