title page of the two editions is identically worded. It is not clear whether it has simply
been transcribed or had been renewed in favour of Paganinis.

The strange calligraphic Italic types used here appear to be a speciality of this press
(Norton, 1958, p. 145).

The words 'impressorum accuratissimi' seem to have been added (?) to the colophon during
printing.
