The existence of this edition is somewhat doubtful. It is recorded by Panzer, whose entry reads ‘Juvenalis cum Ang. Politiani. Phil. Beroaldi et Baptistae Egnatii, Badii item Ascensii annotationibus. Paris. in aedibus Ascensianis MDXIX. fol.’, citing ‘Fabric. Bibl. lat. Harles. T. II, p. 360.’ [Fabricius, *Bibliotheca Latina; Catalogus Bibliothecæ Harleianæ*]

The list of contents given here is suspicious, being found together in no other edition. The three Italian scholars are only to be found in the two Milanese editions of 1514 with Britannicus’s commentary (nos. Juv088 and Juv089). However, the imprint given by Panzer looks convincing and it may be that there was some confusion in his source about the contents of a now lost edition by Badius. The existence of edition is accepted by the editors of Renouard’s *Imprimeurs & libraires parisiens*.
