The copy-text was probably the earlier Lyon 1515 edition by J. Clein edited by Antonius Petrus (Juv091), to which additional notes have been added, marked in the text and in the margin with an asterisk. This edition is not recorded by Baudrier.

The letter by Antoine Pierre appears to be a shorter version of the one in the 1515 edition.

Six of the twenty-three recorded copies are in Spanish libraries, suggesting that part of the edition was intended for the Spanish market.
