The Harvard copy is bound with a Gryphius Horace of 1531. The Harvard catalogue notes
that this is not the same setting of type as the 1533 edition. Printer's mark (Silvestre 211)

This edition appears to be printed on super-chancery paper rather than the narrow median
sheets which almost all octavo editions had used since the first Aldine of 1501 (Juv056).
