Probably a copy of Dumaëus’s Antwerp edition of the previous year (Juv136): both have
an abbreviated version of the wording of the title page.

Joannes Hillenius Hoochstratanus is recorded as both a printer and a bookseller; at this
time he was working in Antwerp using the typographical material of Michael Hillenius
(Rouzet, 1975, p. 93–94).

The Stanford copy is bound with a Horace of the same date printed by Hillenius.

The description of the Utrecht copy is taken from a xerox of A1^r, A1^v and A2^r f.
