The wording of the title page suggests that this is a reprint of the Juvenal from an earlier Lyon edition of Juvenal and Persius which had the additional *De nomine satyra* (e.g. Juv123). The *Carmen adhortatorium* is apparently new to this edition; it is written in elegiac couplets and is spoken by Eloquentia and starts ‘Pace mihi uestra pueri, studiosaque pubes ...’

The Philadelphia copy is bound with a Brylinger edition of Horace of 1543 in a contemporary blind-stamped binding with the initials ‘V F’ and the date ‘1543’.
