***First edition of Juvenal in 12° format***

A small format edition without marginal notes, presumably set from one of Colines’ earlier  
editions (Juv112 and Juv131). Colines also issued a Persius in 1542 (Morgan 146) and a  
Horace (1543) in series with this Juvenal.

The format can be confirmed as 12° from the evidence of the paper. The chainlines are  
horizontal; the watermark is found on the outer edge of \$5,6 in alternate gatherings. This  
is similar to Gaskell’s diagrams for ‘duodecimo with two signatures’ (Gaskell, 1972, p.  
[99], fig. 57). The pages have a width-to-height ratio of 1 : 1.62, which suggests that the  
sheets were narrow median.
