Probably a copy of one of Gryphius’s editions, the most recent of which was that of 1541
(Juv139). A reduction of four leaves has been made in the extent.

The imprint date exists in two states, ‘*M. D. XLV*.’ and ‘*M. D. XLVI*.’ This suggests that
the book was probably printed towards the end of 1545.
