Set from Loëus’s previous edition of 1552 (Juv155). Once again, the Juvenal is accompanied by a Persius and a two-part Horace which carries details of the privilege.

Bodleian Auct. S 6.12 is Theodore Poelman’s copy with the inscription on the title page of the Juvenal ‘Ioannes Loëus Theod. Pulmanno dono dabat’. It is marked up, in Poelman’s hand, apparently in preparation for the 1566 Plantin edition (Juv173). The first item in the volume is a copy of Scaliger’s edition of Manilius (Paris, M. Pattison, 1579) marked up by Scaliger with a number of sheets of manuscript notes of indexes to the text of Manilius in preparation for his second edition of 1599/1600. It seems likely that Scaliger will have borrowed the volume from Plantin after Poelman’s death.
